#### **Year 6 Mini Fete**


#### **Year 6 Mini Fete**

#### **Refund and Returns Policy**

The Uniform Shop strives to offer the best possible service to our school community whilst keeping prices as low as possible. In order to do this, we ask that wherever possible you visit the shop to try before you buy.

With a few exceptions (see below), items may be exchanged for the same item in a different size. If a refund is required, we can issue a store credit that can be used against future purchases.

In order for a return or exchange to be accepted, the item must be returned within **14 days** and be unused in the **original packaging with all tags still attached**. We ask that you let the shop know (by email) that you intend to exchange/return the item and provide us with the date of purchase.

Unfortunately we are unable to offer exchange or return of hats, or socks/stockings (unless unopened) due to hygiene reasons.

Faulty/defective items can be returned anytime within the warranty period and will be returned to the manufacturer for repair.




