Please note planning processes for 2021 classes are now well underway and we are thus not able to accept any further requests regarding class placements.

#### **Presentation Day**

Our annual Presentation Day will be held tomorrow, Thursday 10 December, commencing at 9.15 a.m. for Years 3-6 students and 11.30 a.m. for Kindergarten-Year 2 students. We are looking forward to this opportunity to acknowledge the achievements of students this year. Parents of students who will be receiving awards have been sent a letter informing them of this and will be able to access the assembly via video afterwards.

#### 2021 Staffing

Mr Sheridan will not be returning to our school next year as he has accepted a job at an independent school. Mr Sheridan has been a dedicated member of our staff team at Normanhurst for the past 11 years and will be missed. I have always appreciated the professionalism with which Mr Sheridan approached his role and his great sense of humour. His decision has come about suddenly when an opportunity arose and I only found out myself yesterday. We wish Mr Sheridan all the best with his new endeavour and look forward to hearing from him next year. Ms De Palo will continue relieving as Assistant Principal until Mr Sheridan's role is filled permanently. Ms Tilney will continue working part-time in 2021, having returned this term following maternity leave, and Mr Rosewarn will relieve as Assistant Principal part-time in her absence. We will also welcome new permanent teachers Mr Darren Hills and Ms Darcy Gilroy at the start of 2021. Ms Marianne Stewart has also been appointed permanently to our school which we are very pleased about! Ms Stewart has been working at our school on temporary contracts over the last two years and has been an excellent addition to our staff.

If you have any questions regarding your child's report once you receive it, please see their class teacher.

#### 2021 Beginning of Year arrangements






