Classes and Numbers

As the year is ending, we are currently planning for next year. At this stage, our numbers are changing daily. Next year we are expecting to make 16 classes. Due to numbers these classes will include composite classes, job share classes and single grade classes. Class structure is determined by the staffing formula provided by the Department



of Education. The placing of children into new classes is a complex and time-consuming process as each year we strive to ensure that we have well-balanced classes. This process is currently taking place. When forming balanced classes, many factors are taken into consideration: gender, academic ability, special needs such as learning support, English as an additional language or dialect, behavioural and social needs, medical needs and learning behaviours. As this is a very complex task, and as I have mentioned in previous Newsletters, we do not take parent requests for teachers or for students to be placed together. Teachers use their professionalism as they place students in a class that will best meet student educational needs. Thank you for your support with this process.






