- provide teacher comments to describe student learning and identify the next steps in learning.
- Use of the five-point, A-E scale for grading is not required; however, the equivalent word descriptors may be used through teacher comments to provide a consistent language for reporting progress and achievement on the learning students have undertaken

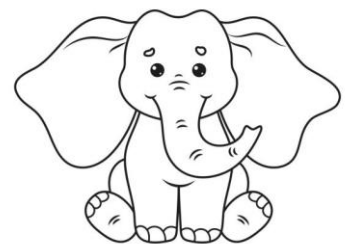
1. Students in K-2 must send a video of their performance to Mrs Chan by 4pm, Monday 6th of December. (ada.chan7@det.nsw.edu.au)

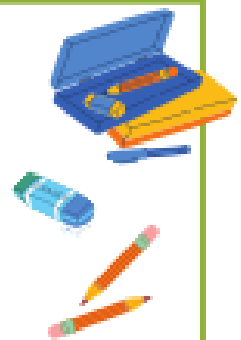

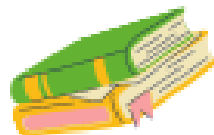

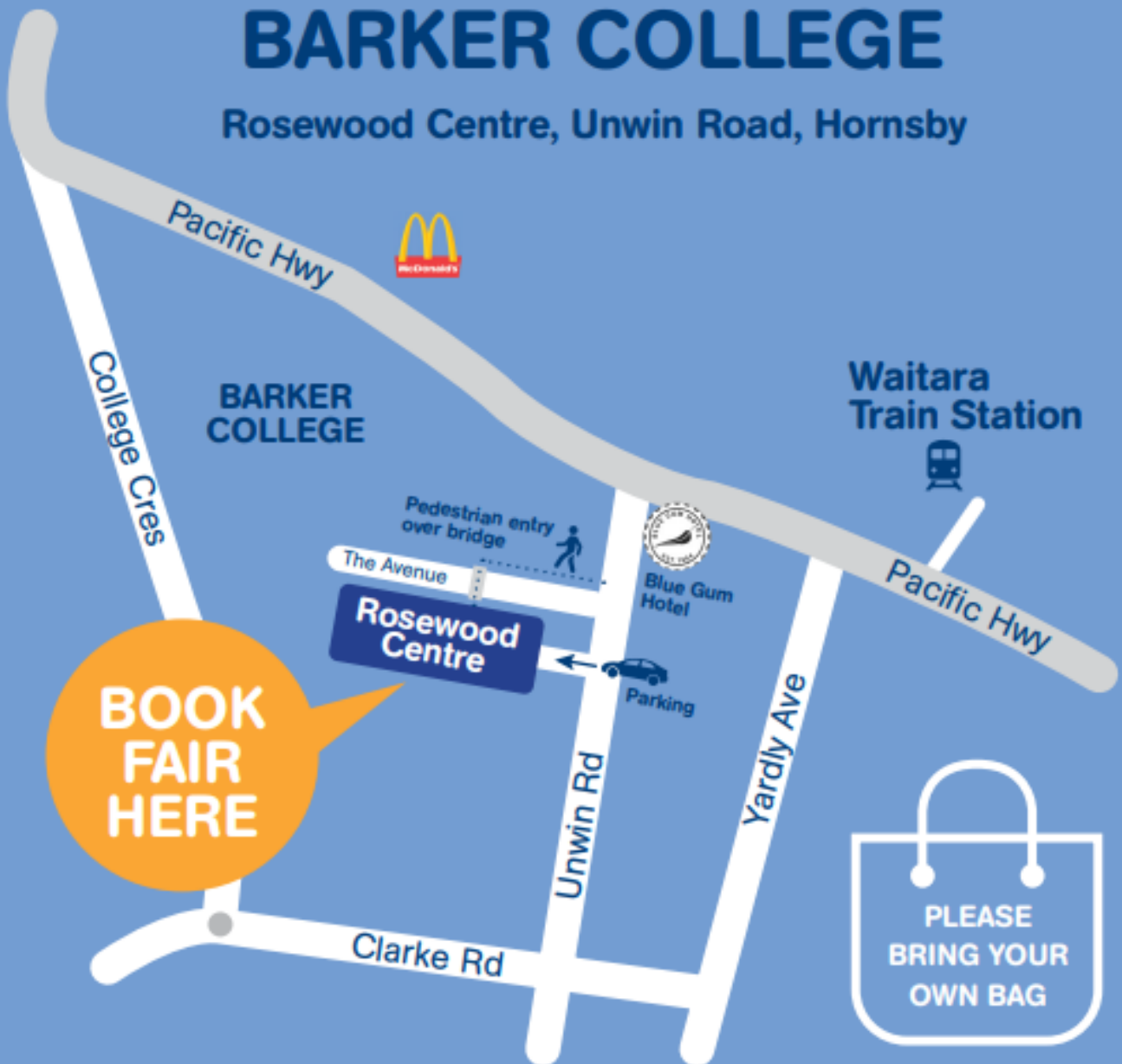
