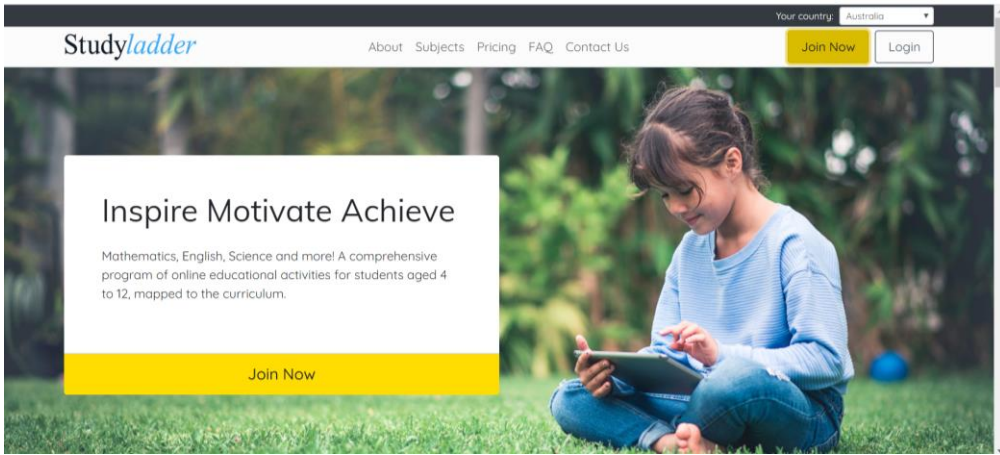


# What else can my child access online to support their learning at home?

## StudyLadder - <https://www.studyladder.com.au/>

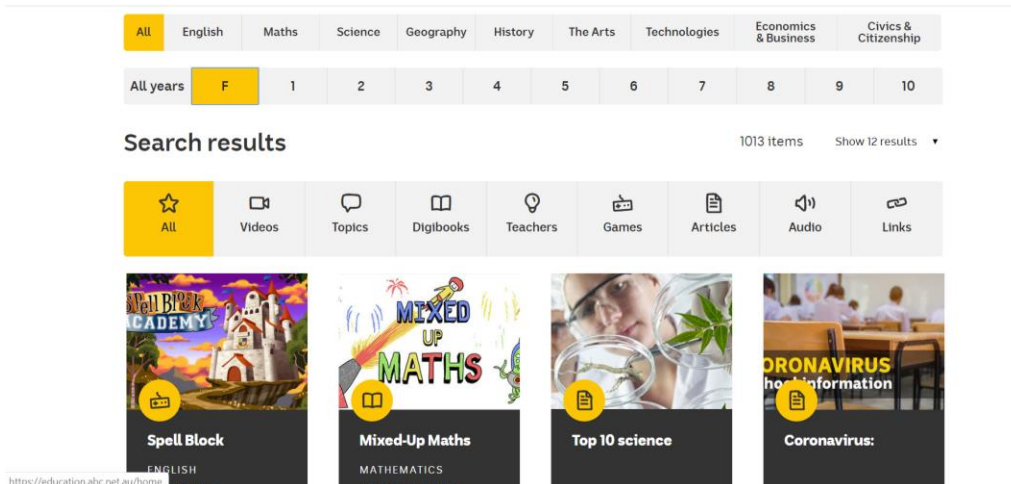
StudyLadder is an Australian website that aligns well with the Australian Curriculum. A basic account can be created for free by parents.

ABC Education has a range of resources available including videos and games. No account is required to access this site.



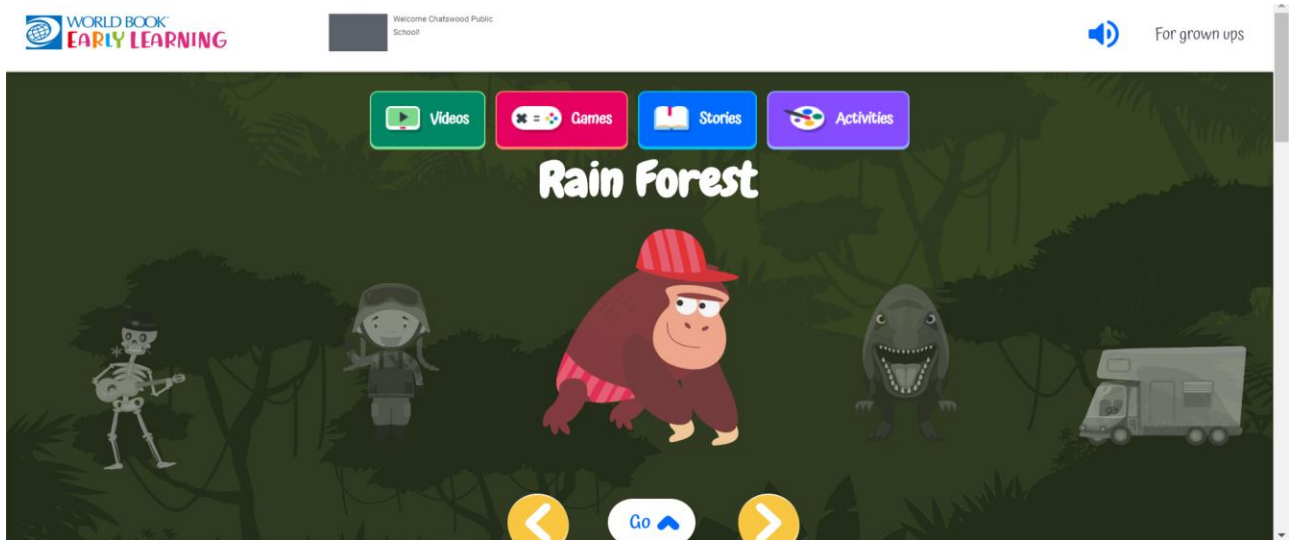

Worldbook online has a range of resources for early learners including books, games and activities. You can login using our school account.

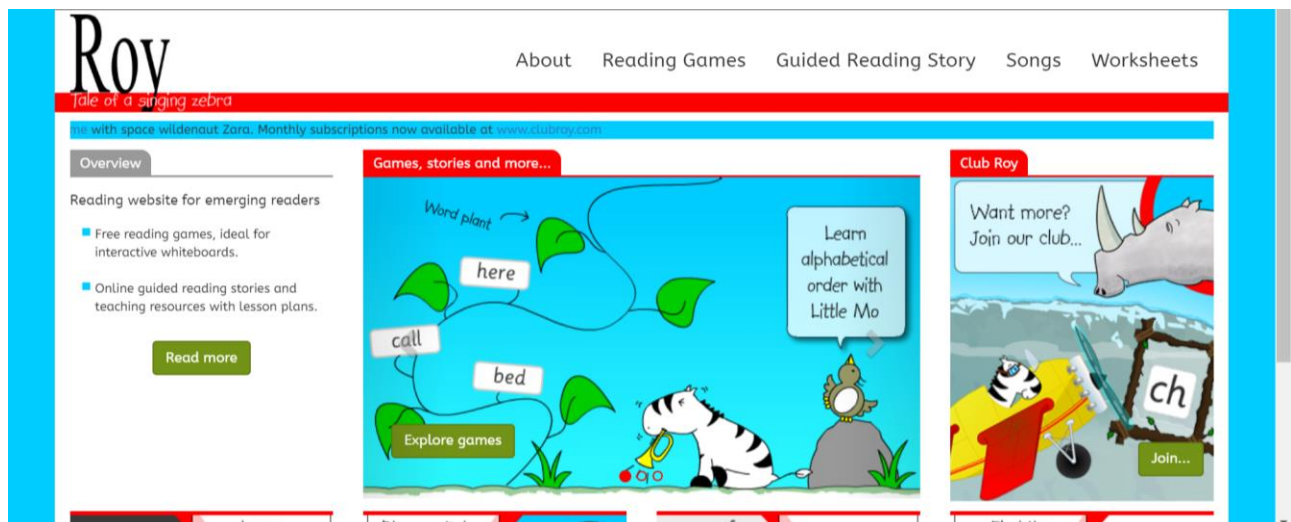

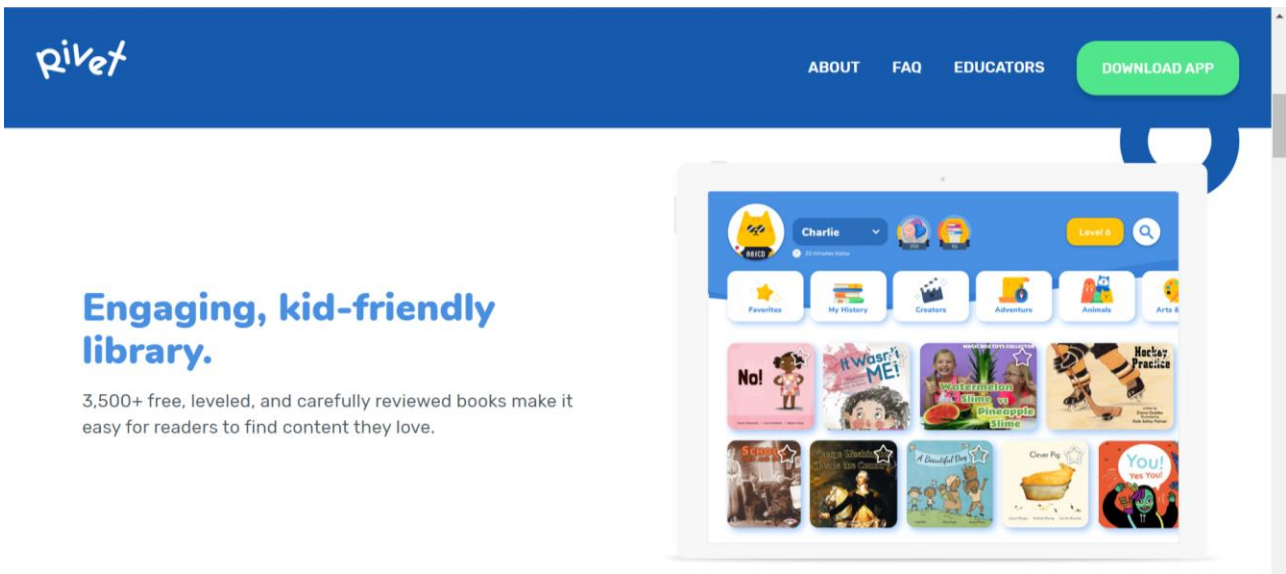

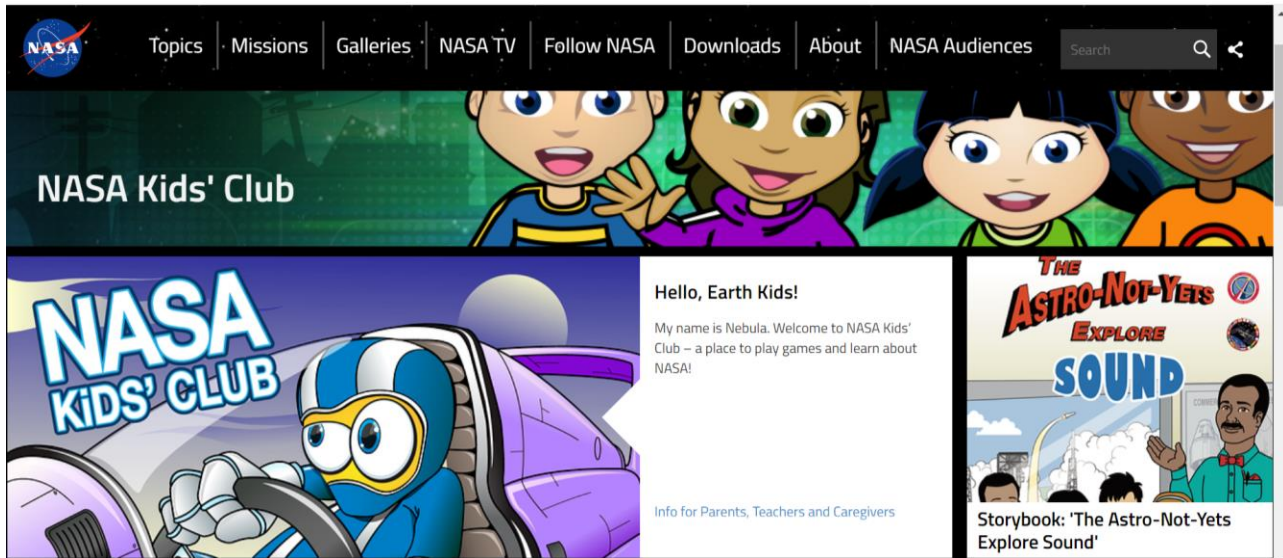

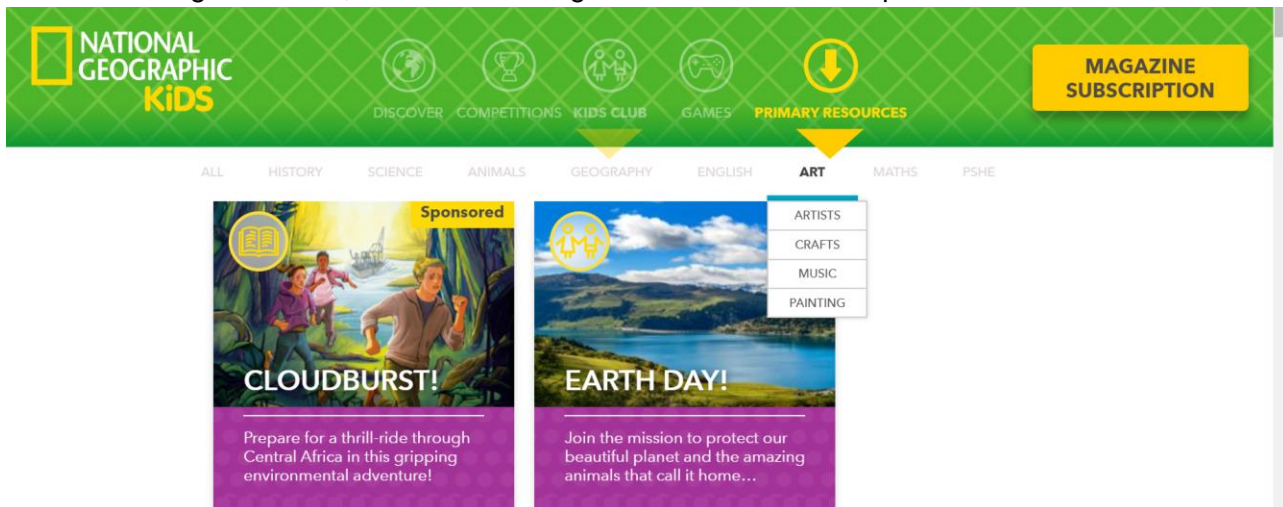
